Abstract Submissions

We would like to invite the submissions of abstracts relating to any aspect of physiotherapy and older people. This could include research projects, audits or service developments

Abstracts should be a maximum of 500 words (not including Title, author details and references) and should be submitted as a word document to researchchagile@gmail.com with Agile Conference Abstract as the subject header.

Your abstract should include the following sections:

Title and authors	An abstract title Name and contact details of the main author Name and institution of co-authors
Introduction	Purpose of the project and why it is important
Method	Brief summary of the methods used for the project
Results:	These may be preliminary at the time of submission of the abstract
Discussion:	This should be in relation to results and give some context/explanation to the results
Conclusion	Implications or recommendations for practice/further research
References	A maximum of 4 references may be included and are also not included in the word count
Governance	Details of any ethics, local NHS approval etc. Approvals may not have been required for some projects but please state if ethical or local NHS approval was not required

Closing date for submission of abstracts is 5th August 2019 and you will be informed of a decision by 19th August 2019.

Successful abstracts will be accepted as a poster presentation with the possibility of an oral presentation

Successful presenters will be expected to register and pay for attendance at the appropriate fee. Please note that the event may sell out ahead of the closing day and so you are advised to book a place as soon as possible through Eventbrite. Early Bird prices available until 24th June 2019
